

ENGINEERING DIVISION PLAN CHECK SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENT CHECKLIST-

To ensure timely processing, applicants should check their submittal packages for completeness and compliance to the following checklist. City staff will inventory these items upon submittal and mark either N/A or T.B.D. for any items not submitted.

A Grading Permit application package for first submittal shall consist of the following items and forms in order to be considered complete, unless otherwise specified by the City Engineer:

- This Submittal Checklist.
- Completed and signed City Engineering Plan Check Application form.
- <u>**Two**</u> copies of any City Conditions of Approval for the project, if applicable.
- <u>**Two**</u> sets of the signed & stamped grading plans prepared in accordance with the City's standards and requirements.
- <u>**Two**</u> copies each of the site-specific soils & geology reports prepared by an geotechnical engineering firm including a written review of the most recent grading plan. These reports shall all be wet-signed & stamped by a Civil (or Geotechnical) Engineer and an Engineering Geologist registered in the State of California.
- <u>**Two**</u> copies of wet signed & stamped Hydrology and Hydraulic calculations, as determined by the City Engineer.
- <u>**Two**</u> sets of signed & stamped Erosion Control Plans incorporated into the grading plan sets.
- <u>One</u> copy of completed and signed WQMP Determination Form. Click the link below: <u>https://villapark.org/LinkClick.aspx?fileticket=jxqsNbV3aH0%3d&portalid=0×tam</u> <u>p=1730129639305</u>
- <u>**Two**</u> copies of wet signed & stamped Water Quality Management Plans (WQMP) if determined to be 'significant development' or 'priority project' per the above WQMP Determination Form.
- <u>**Two**</u> physical copies, and one electronic copy of signed & stamped Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) binder if determined to be 'significant development' or 'priority project' (see WQMP Determination Form above)
- <u>One</u> original and one copy of a Notarized letter of permission from any adjacent property owners granting permission for any grading activities or encroachments onto adjacent properties.(if applicable)
- Payment of plan check fees
